Conversation Starters: Ask. Ask. Ask.

Work related:

- o What company do you work for?
- o What do you do for (company)?
- o What does that entail?

Get a sense for the company:

- o I'm not familiar with ---, what's the product?
- o How many employees are at ---?
- o How many offices? Where?
- o Is it public or private?
- o Do you manage a team? How many?
- o What position do you report to?
- o How long have you been with ---?

Get a deeper conversation going:

- o How's work going this week?
- o How's business?
- O What have you been working on lately?

Related to the speaker or event:

- O What brought you out to this event today?
- o Do you have a particular interest in this topic?
- What did you think about the speaker? or ... this event?
- o Have you ever been to this restaurant / venue before?

Related to the organization putting on the event:

- o Have you come to these events before?
- O How long have you been a member of ----?
- o What do you find is the best part of being a member of ----?

(Appropriate) personal questions:

- o How's your week going so far?
- Seasonal: Do you have any:
 - (fall & winter) plans for the holidays?
 - (spring & summer) vacation plans?
- o Do you have any plans for the weekend?
- o Where do you live? Or...Where did you drive from to get here?

My favorites:

- 1. So...what do you do when you're not (thing that is happening now, i.e., attending xyz events)? This gives people the option to talk about work or anything else they choose.
- 2. What do you do for fun? (...though, be careful with this one: not everyone has fun...and it may catch some people off guard.)
